**Subject: Permission to sell Travel Medical Insurance in the Schengen area**

Dear Mr Chakrit Tiebtienrat,

On behalf of the Schengen Member States represented in Bangkok, I am pleased to inform you that the application of JP Insurance Public Company Limited to be added to the list of approved Travel Medical and Insurance Companies for the Schengen area has been successful.

Your application was approved by the Local Schengen Cooperation (LSC) group during its meeting on 27 August 2019. Due to the fact that JP Insurance Public Company Limited has signed the Code of Conduct, it can now start selling Travel Medical Insurance *provided it abides by the rules of the Code of Conduct*. Please note that any breach of the Code of Conduct will result in a refusal by any Schengen embassy. Insurance companies are fully responsible for their authorised agents.

JP Insurance Public Company Limited may now use the term "approved for Visa-application by all EU Schengen Embassies" to advertise their product. The company will be included in an updated list of approved Travel Medical Insurance Companies for the Schengen area, and circulated among Schengen Member States represented in Bangkok.
